Accompanied by more than 1,200 kids, the three children of St. Lazare chiropractor, Dr. Patrick Lepage – Charles-Antoine, age five, Juliette age seven and Émilie age ten – completed the 42nd kilometre of the Ottawa marathon journey they began last December in support of children with cancer. 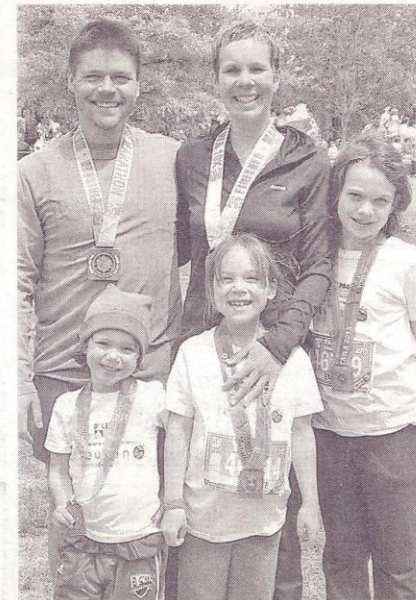
chiropractor completed the May 26 marathon, himself, in 4 hours, 28 minutes, while his wife Geneviève completed a 10k run the day before.
